

Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service Emergency Medical Scholarship

The Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service has been in service since 1988. They recognize the importance and need for educated emergency responders for the local community and wish to demonstrate this by offering a scholarship to individuals pursuing qualifications as an Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) and/or an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT).

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent GED
- Must be living in the surrounding area

Additional Requirements: The applicant must write a short essay which should include the following points:

- Applicant's interest in pursuing a career as an EMR or EMT
- Need for Financial Assistance
- Career goals
- Include one individual to be contacted as a reference

Scholarship Selection: The Hillsboro EMT Service will determine the scholarship recipient(s) and contact will be made to the student's provided information. Students are encouraged to update the Hillsboro Area EMTs on their course progress.

Funds Disbursement: Proof of student enrollment in the aforementioned course(s) is required to be provided to the Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service. Student enrollment may be mailed to Hillsboro Area Ambulance Service, P.O. Box 211, Hillsboro WI, 54634. Full payment of the course(s) tuition, textbooks and certification exams will be sent to the student's designated college. The Scholarship amount is up to \$1400.00 and will be dispersed per discretion of the Hillsboro Area Ambulance board.

Student Obligations: After completion of the program, students are agreed that such financial assistance shall be contingent upon the student's commitment to, upon request by the Hillsboro EMT Service, serve as a paid employee for the term of 1 year. This commitment will include 20 on call hours per month and two 8 hour weekend shifts. You must attend 6 meetings and 6 trainings per year in order to have their refresher and CPR paid for by the service. Students must be within 5 minutes of travel to the Ambulance Service, or be willing to serve shifts at the Ambulance building. Upon completion of the course, the student is required to agree to a service start date within one month.

Additional Training Opportunities: The Hillsboro EMT Service requires students to maintain their earned certifications and will provide compensation for continuing education.

Consequences of Termination: If a student fails to complete the course to which the scholarship is awarded and aforementioned service agreement, full compensation must be returned to the Hillsboro Area Ambulance Board.
